

GENERAL MEMBERS' CODE OF BEHAVIOUR & ETHICS

As a registered member of the Brisbane Buccaneers Ice Hockey Club Incorporate (the 'Club'), all individuals agree to abide by the Club's Member Code of Behaviour and Ethics. This Member Code applies to all Club members, including players, coaches, officials, administrators, managers, office holders and employees. As a member of the Club the participants are to adhere to the following requirements in regard to their behaviour during any activity held by or under the auspices of the Club or a Member State or Territory Association and in any role they hold within the Club or a Member State or Territory Association.

- 1. All members of the Brisbane Buccaneers Ice Hockey Club must comply with all applicable local, state, and federal laws
- 2. No member shall engage in or promote any illegal activities while representing the club
- 3. Abide by Iceworld Olympic Ice Rink Conditions of Entry including but not limited to assumptions of risk, general obligations, restricted activities and prohibited behaviour and ice sports hire
- 4. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others;
- 5. Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealing with others by being a positive role model at all times.
- 6. Be professional in, and accept responsibility for their actions;
- 7. Make a commitment to providing quality service by providing a safe environment for the conduct of the activity;
- 8. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility, especially when dealing with persons under 18 years of age, as your words and actions serve as examples;
- 9. Be aware of and maintain an uncompromising adhesion to the Club's standards, Constitution, By-Laws and policies;
- Operate within the rules of ice hockey including national and international guidelines, which govern the Club, Ice Hockey Australia and the Member State and Territory Associations;
- 11. Understand their responsibility if they breach or are aware of any breaches of this Code of Behaviour & Ethics:
- 12. Do not use their involvement with the Club, Ice Hockey Australia or a Member State or Territory Association to promote their own beliefs, behaviors or practices where these are inconsistent with those of the Club, Ice Hockey Australia and the Member State or Territory Association;
- 13. Avoid unaccompanied and unobserved activities with persons under 18 years of age in accordance with the Club's Member Protection Policy;
- 14. Refrain from any form of abuse, harassment or discrimination towards others;
- 15. Show concern and caution towards others who may be ill or injured;
